A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A FLOCK CAMERA SYSTEM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$28,000 FOR USE BY PUBLIC SAFETY; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT TO EFFECTUATE SAME; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs has examined the use of a camera system for surveillance purposes to assist the Criminal Investigations Division in its investigations and in response to public requests for said camera and finds it in the interest of public health, safety and welfare to purchase and install a cameras in certain public areas within the City;

WHEREAS, the Flock Camera System is recommended for consistency of use by Cobb County and other cities in Cobb and as a less expensive system, and seizure funds are available to fund purchase and installation;

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes and approves the purchase and installation of a Flock Camera System and ten cameras for the amount of \$28,000 using seizure funds, and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement to effectuate same, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
