A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH COBB COUNTY TO SHARE COSTS RELATED TO RESURFACING OF CARTER ROAD; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") and Cobb County ("County") desire to resurface Carter Road, which is located within Powder Springs and the unincorporated area; and

WHEREAS the City and County find it in the public interest to resurface Carter Road and share in the proportional costs of said resurfacing, with the amount attributable to each party based upon that section of the road contained within the respective jurisdiction; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the form of the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Powder Springs and Cobb County relating to the resurfacing of Carter Road, and attached as Exhibit A, is approved, and the Mayor is authorized to execute said agreement in form substantially similar to Exhibit A, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
