This Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the Project Framework Agreement, ("Supplemental Agreement No. 1"), is made and entered into on this \_\_\_\_\_\_ ("Effective Date"), by and between the GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, an agency of the State of Georgia, hereinafter called the "DEPARTMENT", and THE CITY OF POWDER SPRINGS, GEORGIA, hereinafter called the "SPONSOR."

WHEREAS, the DEPARTMENT and the SPONSOR entered into a Project Framework Agreement dated, October 31, 2022, for Contract ID: 48400-425-PFAOPD2300196 hereinafter called the "ORIGINAL AGREEMENT", for the purpose of having the SPONSOR reimbursed federal funds for PI # 0019207, Powder Springs Silver Comet Trail Connector – LCI, the project begins at Pineview Drive Southwest, running along Jackson Way and Old Lost Mountain Road for 0.45 miles, concluding at Silver Comet Trail, such work hereinafter called the "PROJECT", and

WHEREAS, the DEPARTMENT and the SPONSOR agree that additional funds are needed to complete preconstruction engineering (design) activities, hereinafter referred to as "PE".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES mutually agree that for and in consideration of the mutual benefits to flow from each to the other the ORIGINAL AGREEMENT shall be modified as follows:

1. The current Exhibit A, TIP/STIP Insert, shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the revised Exhibit A, attached hereto.

2. The following attachments appended to this Supplemental Agreement No. 1 are hereby incorporated by reference into and made part of the ORIGINAL AGREEMENT, and shall have the same force and effect as if set forth in full therein:
