

RESOLUTION 2018-147

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A BID FROM ATLANTA AIR CARE, LLC FOR HEATING, VENTILATION, AND AIR CONDITIONING REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT AT CITY HALL AND THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AT A COST OF \$8,098.00; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO EFFECTUATE SAME; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the heating, ventilation, air conditioning (HVAC) unit which serves the computer server room at City of Powder Springs City Hall is in need of replacement, or its leaks could cause damage; and

WHEREAS, there is an HVAC unit at the Public Works Department also in need of replacement due to its unsafe condition; and

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (the "City") advertised for and received bids to replace both HVAC units; and


WHEREAS, Atlanta Air Care, LLC was deemed to be the lowest and most responsive bidder with a bid in the total amount of \$8,098.00; and

WHEREAS, funding is available as part of the 2016 SPLOST Facility Improvement Task; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to accept said bid and award the project to Atlanta Air Care, LLC.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the bid of Atlanta Air Care, LLC to replace HVAC units at City Hall and Public Works is hereby accepted and approved, and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement to effectuate same after review and approval by the City Attorney. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.






