

ORDINANCE 2016-015

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE FISCAL YEAR 2016 BUDGET TO ACCOUNT FOR INCREASED REVENUES AND EXPENSES AS A RESULT OF BUILDING PERMIT ISSUANCE; TO ACCOUNT FOR INCREASED REVENUES AND EXPENSES WITHIN THE SENIOR CENTER ACCOUNT AS A RESULT OF DONATIONS AND REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE COSTS; TO ACCOUNT FOR THE RECEIPT AND APPROPRIATION OF IMPACT FEE COLLECTIONS; TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (the "City") has an established impact fee program for public safety and parks and recreation and said impact fees are collected at issuance of building permits and used to improve the Silver Comet Trail Linear Park and to repay the 2006 bond for the purchase and renovation of the Powder Springs Police Department;

WHEREAS, the City has collected said impact fees for the period March to May 2016 and desires to adopt a budget amendment for the collection and appropriation of said fees;


WHEREAS, the City has issued additional building permit fees that has resulted in an increase in revenues and related expenses associated with building permit plan reviews and inspections and desires to adopt a budget amendment to account for the increased revenues and expenses;


WHEREAS, the City has received additional donations for the Senior Center as well as incurred increased expenses associated with repairs and maintenance and operating supplies and materials for the Senior Center and desires to adopt a budget amendment to account for the increased revenues and expenses;

NOW THEREFORE, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs hereby ordain that the budget ordinance for the fiscal year 2016 be amended as provided in the attached schedule.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon execution.

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
