

RESOLUTION 2026 - 075

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF POWDER SPRINGS, GEORGIA CERTIFYING AN ESTIMATED MILLAGE RATE FOR THE 2026 TAX YEAR; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") is the levying authority responsible for adopting ad valorem property taxes to provide for the operations of city government; and

WHEREAS O.C.G.A. § 48-5-32.1 (as amended by House Bill 581) requires the levying authority to certify to the County Board of Tax Assessors and Tax Commissioner an estimated rollback rate to be included on the annual Notice of Assessment; and

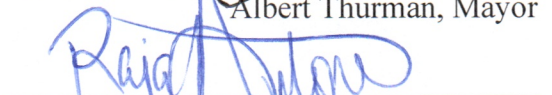
WHEREAS the Cit has reviewed the preliminary tax digest, estimated reassessments, and the proposed operating budget for the next fiscal year and desires to establish an estimated millage rate for the 2026 tax year to provide taxpayers with accurate preliminary information regarding their taxes.

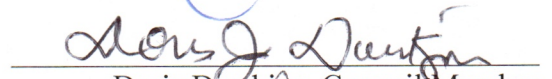
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that it certifies an estimated tax rate of 9.5 mills for the 2026 tax year, which is based on the preliminary digest and is intended to maintain the current rate, and authorizes the Finance Director to submit this certified estimate to the Cobb County Board of Tax Assessors and Tax Commissioners.

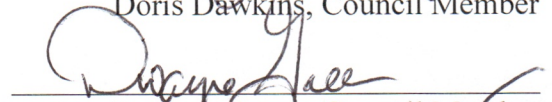
