A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN APPLICATION FOR A HOME DEPOT COMMERCIAL ACCOUNT FOR U.S. COMMUNITIES PARTICIPANTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
