A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CHIEF OF POLICE TO COMPLETE, EXECUTE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GEORGIA LAW ENFORCEMENT CERTIFICATION PROGRAM; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the Georgia Association of Chiefs of Police with the Georgia Police Accreditation Coalition previously developed a Georgia Law Enforcement Certification Program (GLECP) setting forth law enforcement agency standards governing operations every three years; and

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs desires to apply to renew its participation in GLECP and commit to earning certification in accordance with the requirements set forth by the Georgia Association of Chief of Police; and

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor and Chief of Police are authorized to complete, execute and apply to renew the City's participation in the Georgia Law Enforcement Certification Program, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
