

RESOLUTION NO. 2026 - 109

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A REVOCABLE LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR THE LIMITED USE OF CITY-OWNED PROPERTY FOR HUNTING PURPOSES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs (“the City”) owns certain real property located at (“Property”); and

WHEREAS the City has determined that the Property is not presently needed for active municipal purposes and may be suitable for limited recreational use under controlled conditions; and

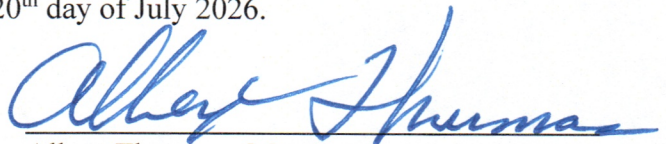
WHEREAS the Charles Hudson family has requested permission to access and use the Property for lawful hunting activities; and

WHEREAS the Licensee has offered to perform litter removal on the Property as consideration for such use, and City finds that allowing such limited use pursuant to a revocable license agreement, subject to appropriate terms, conditions, and insurance requirements, serves a public purpose by assisting with the cleanliness of City property; and

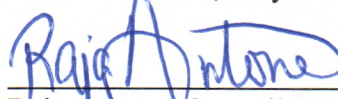
WHEREAS a license confers no property interest and may be revoked by the City at any time in its sole discretion.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor is authorized to execute a Revocable License Agreement between the City and Charles Hudson family for the limited purpose of hunting on designated portions of the Property, subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations in exchange for litter removal services.

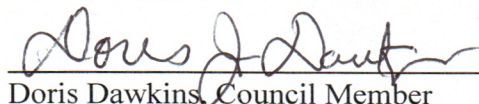
