A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR PROTEM TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH COBB COUNTY RELATING TO THE UPGRADE, FUNDING, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT CERTAIN LOCATIONS WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs desires to upgrade and improve traffic signals at three intersections in the City on Marietta Street at Brownsville Road, New Macland Road and Austell Powder Spring Road; and

WHEREAS the City will pay for the engineering, right of way, utility relocation and construction required for the signal upgrades, and the County will assume operation and maintenance of the signals after the upgrades have been completed;

WHEREAS the City and County anticipate the total project cost to be approximately \$300,000.00, and the City will pay from the 2022 Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax Program funds; and

WHEREAS both parties desire to reflect their mutual agreements and benefits in writing.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor or Mayor Pro Tem is authorized to execute an agreement with Cobb County in form substantially similar to the attached for the upgrade of three signals in the City, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
