AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021 TO ESTABLISH A BUDGET FOR THE HOTEL/MOTEL TAX FUND; TO AMEND THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022 TO ESTABLISH A BUDGET FOR THE HOTEL/MOTEL TAX FUND; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") had the opportunity to collect a hotel/motel tax beginning in Fiscal Year 2021 with the opening of a new business subject to said tax; and

WHEREAS, the City's auditor recommended that the City amend its FY21 budget to establish a budget for the hotel/motel tax fund and further recommended that the City amend its FY22 budget to establish a budget for the hotel/motel tax fund and allocate expenses for the remittance of a portion of the hotel/motel tax to state agencies per governing law; and


WHEREAS, the City desires to accept the recommendation of its auditor to amend the FY21 and FY22 budgets to establish a budget for the hotel/motel tax fund;

NOW THEREFORE, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs hereby ordain that the budget ordinance for the Fiscal Year 2021 be amended as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" and that the budget ordinance for Fiscal Year 2022 be amended as set forth in Exhibit "B".

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith hereby repealed, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon execution by the Mayor and City Council.




