

RESOLUTION NO. 2026 - 005

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MARIETTA STREET ON JANUARY 15, 2026 BETWEEN 6 AND 9PM TO FACILITATE A CITY PUBLIC MEETING TO BE HELD AT LOCAL DOWNTOWN BUSINESSES FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECEIVING INPUT AND FEEDBACK ABOUT CERTAIN PLANNING RECOMMENDATIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs engaged the planning firm TSW to update the City's downtown redevelopment plans outlined in the Livable Centers Initiative (LCI) plan and to assess and recommend uses for the City's public facilities located at the Ford Center campus and the former Primitive Baptist Church at Old Lost Mountain Road; and


WHEREAS the update and assessment efforts have been ongoing for several months, including public involvement initiatives and surveys resulting in draft concepts and recommendations.


WHEREAS to encourage continued public engagement and feedback as much as possible, the City and TSW will present the concepts and recommendations at downtown local businesses on January 15 from 6pm to 9pm, and the city desires to approve the temporary closure of Marietta Street to facilitate safe and direct public access between these locations to view the concepts and recommendations.


