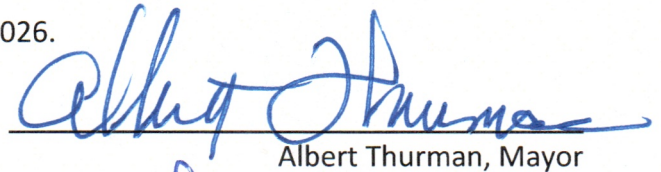

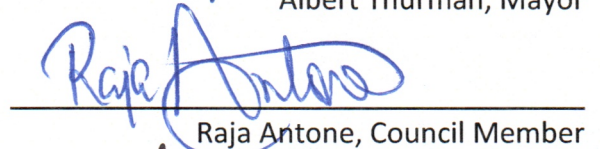
WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs periodically experiences vacancies or unplanned absences that may affect operations; and

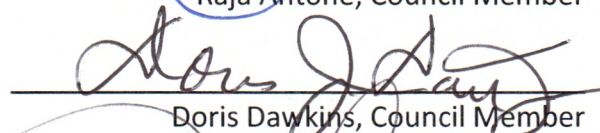
WHEREAS, temporary employment agencies can provide timely staffing support when vacancies or absences adversely affect City operations, as determined by the senior management team and the City Manager.

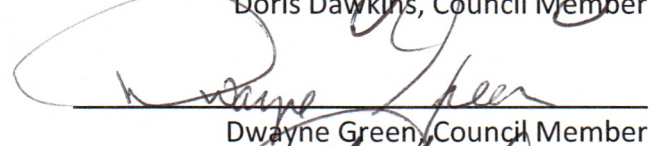
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor is approved and authorized to execute agreements or related documents necessary to engage temporary employment agencies when prolonged, multiple, or overlapping vacancies or absences affect City operations, as determined by the senior management team and approved by the City Manager, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney and the availability of budgeted funds.

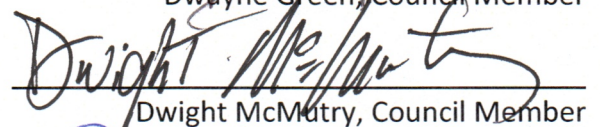

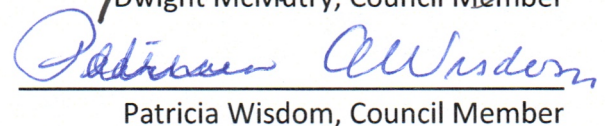

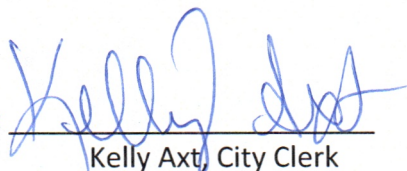
