

## RESOLUTION 2021 - 064

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**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF ARDITO CONSTRUCTION FOR THE REPAIR OF CERTAIN SIDEWALKS AND CURBS FOR THE SUM OF \$4,849; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR SUCH SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

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**WHEREAS**, portions of sidewalks and curbing maintained by the City of Powder Springs (the "City") in the right-of-way on Liberty Drive, Oak Lane and Warren Farm Road are currently in need of repair; and

**WHEREAS**, the City solicited and did receive quotes to provide the necessary labor, materials, and equipment to effect the repairs; and

**WHEREAS**, Ardito Construction did prepare and submit a proposal to provide such labor, materials, and equipment at a cost of \$4,849; and


**WHEREAS**, the City finds the quote of Ardito Construction to be the lowest responsible and responsive proposal for such work, and the Mayor and Council wish to enter into such an agreement with Ardito Construction in order to effectuate the desired work.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that that an agreement with Ardito Construction to provide the necessary labor, materials, and equipment to repair portions of sidewalks and curbs on Liberty Drive, Oak Lane and Warren Farm Road is hereby approved, and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement to effectuate same after review and approval by the City Attorney. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.



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


