A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE ANNUAL ANTICIPATED COLLECTIONS ADDENDUM TO THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY OBLIGATING APPROPRIATIONS TO COVER TRANSACTION PRICES FOR INQUIRIES MADE THROUGH THE SYSTEMATIC ALIEN VERIFICATION FOR ENTITLEMENTS ("SAVE") PROGRAM; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs has registered and executed an agreement with the Department of Homeland Security, United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (DHS-USCIS) to participate in the Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) program to determine the immigration status of an individual applying for a public benefit;

WHEREAS, pursuant to said agreement, the City of Powder Springs is required each year to obligate funds sufficient to reimburse DHS-USCIS and confirm said obligation by executing an Anticipated Collections Addendum from Non-Federal Sources in the form attached hereto;

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs desires to complete said addendum in order to complete the memorandum of agreement with DHS-USCIS and obligate funds to cover transaction prices for inquiries made through the SAVE program;






