

RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - 122

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING A TEMPORARY EVENT PERMIT FOR THE USE OF BROAD STREET ON SEPTEMBER 4, 2021 FROM 10AM TO 9PM FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACCOMMODATING AN EVENT TO CELEBRATE THE ONE YEAR ANNIVERSARY OF THE BUSINESS OPENING; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Rooted Trading Company has applied for a permit to hold an event that will include food trucks and other special vendors on Broad Street on September 4, 2021 to commemorate the one-year anniversary of its grand opening; and

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs desires to accommodate said event and approve issuance of a special event permit, subject to cleanup and oversight standards as well as current health guidelines and in accordance with public health emergency executive orders issued by the State and City;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes issuance of a special event permit to Rooted Trading Company for the use of Broad Street on September 4, 2021 to commemorate the one-year anniversary of its grand opening, subject to current health guidelines to include social distancing, mask use, handwashing, clean up and engagement of certain city staff. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
