
A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE DEDUCTIVE CHANGE ORDER TO THE AGREEMENT WITH SUMMIT CONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT, LLC FOR THE BROWNSVILLE ROAD TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND STAFF TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS NEEDED TO CLOSE AND ACCEPT THE PROJECT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") previously authorized Summit Construction and Development, LLC ("Summit") to complete transportation improvements along Brownsville Road between Hiram-Lithia Springs Road and U.S. 278 (the "Project"); and


WHEREAS, Summit has completed said improvements and has submitted a change order to reflect final contract price, and the City desires to accept said change order and close the Project.


