A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND STAFF TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS NEEDED TO COMPLY WITH THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO THE LOCAL ADMINISTERED PROJECT CERTIFICATION AND THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITY TRANSITION PLAN; RATIFYING INSPECTIONS OF PUBLIC FACILITIES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs (the "City") previously adopted an Americans with Disabilities Transition Plan ("ADA Plan"), which requires updates, renewals or status reports relating to implementation of recommendations made in the ADA Plan; and

WHEREAS as part of the Local Administered Project ("LAP") certification received by the City from the Georgia Department of Transportation ("GDOT") in January 2024 to manage and oversee federally funded transportation improvement projects, the City received notice that it must submit an updated and current ADA Plan not later than March 15, 2024; and

WHEREAS the City building official and city engineer were requested to immediately conduct the necessary inspections of public facilities ("ADA Inspections"), which have been completed for inclusion in the ADA Plan under the code enforcement budget; and

**WHEREAS** the City desires to ratify the inspections and approve and submit an updated ADA Plan to the GDOT by the required deadline.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and ratifies the ADA inspections and authorizes the mayor and staff to submit and execute documents required by GDOT to update the ADA Plan, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney of any contractual document.
