A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH LONG ENGINEERING TO PREPARE CONSTRUCTION PLANS AND APPLICATIONS AND OBTAIN A STREAM BUFFER VARIANCE, IF NEEDED, TO REMEDY THE SCOUR AND EROSION OCCURRING AT THE LEWIS ROAD BRIDGE FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$35,700; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Powder Springs (the "City") Public Works Department has identified ongoing erosion and scouring at the footings of the Lewis Road bridge, which can impact the integrity of the bridge if not addressed;

WHEREAS, proposals were solicited and obtained, and the City desires to accept the proposal submitted by Long Engineering as the lowest most responsive proposal to evaluate the scouring, develop remediation plans to remedy the problem, and prepare necessary environmental documents that may be required to complete construction to reverse and improve the problem, including obtaining State and City stream buffer variances, if needed;

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Long Engineering for an amount not to exceed \$35,700, plus expense, to complete work described in its proposal, including obtaining any required stream buffer variance, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
