A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE AND STIPEND FROM THE COBB & DOUGLAS PUBLIC HEALTH (CDPH) DEPARTMENT TO HELP IMPLEMENT THE TOBACCO FREE PARKS AND RECREATION POLICY ADOPTED BY THE CITY OF POWDER SPRINGS; AUTHORIZING THE PARKS AND RECREATION DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CDPH; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Cobb & Douglas Public Health Department (CDPH) provides technical support and a stipend to communities to effectively communicate tobacco-free policies;

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs earlier adopted a resolution and ordinance prohibiting tobacco use in public facilities, including parks, and desires to accept the technical assistance and stipend from the CDPH to help with the City's education and enforcement efforts related to said policy in accordance with the terms of the attached partnership agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the Parks and Recreation Director is authorized to execute the attached agreement with Cobb & Douglas Public Health Department, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
