

RESOLUTION 2021 - 119

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF SMYRNA TERMINATING SMYRNA'S 911 EMERGENCY CALL ANSWERING SERVICES AND APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A NEW INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH COBB COUNTY TO PROVIDE SUCH 911 EMERGENCY CALL ANSWERING SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs did previously enter into an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Smyrna for the Provision of 911 Emergency Call Answering Services whereby the City of Smyrna would receive and dispatch emergency calls on behalf of the City of Powder Springs beginning November 1, 2017 (hereinafter, "the 911 Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the term of the 911 Agreement was to be for ten (10) years, but it also provided that it could be terminated by mutual agreement prior to such time; and

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs desires to terminate the 911 Agreement and enter into a similar agreement with Cobb County, Georgia, and the City of Smyrna is in concurrence.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with the City of Smyrna terminating the 911 Agreement and that it further approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Cobb County to receive and dispatch emergency calls on behalf of the City of Powder Springs. The Mayor is authorized to execute the agreements necessary to effectuate the purposes of this resolution after review and approval by the City Attorney. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.




