

RESOLUTION 2021-052

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLES; AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS FOR THE PURCHASE AND EQUIPPING OF FOUR FORD EXPLORERS FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$191,196; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs has a rolling stock of vehicles assigned to sworn personnel, a number of which are beyond the recommended useful life of five years;

WHEREAS, the City authorized the purchase of two vehicles in the FY21 capital budget but has determined it in the interest of public health and safety to replace an additional two vehicles for an average of four vehicles each year;


WHEREAS, the City desires to authorize the purchase and equipping of four Ford Explorers from under state contract with Vigil Ford for an amount of \$33,879 for each vehicle and \$13,420 for each set of vehicle equipment from Dana Supply and \$500 each for decals from Gregory Quality Printing for an overall total amount of \$191,196 using capital funds, seizure funds and Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax funds remaining in the public safety budget;


BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the purchase and equipping of four Ford Explorers under state contract for an amount of \$191,196 and authorizes the Mayor to execute any agreements required to complete said purchase, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.




