

## RESOLUTION NO. 2026 - 111

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS OR DOCUMENTS TO PURCHASE AND INSTALL ART AND PLANTS AND SIMILAR MOVABLE DECORATIVE ITEMS FOR CITY HALL; AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$28,000 FOR THE ITEMS AND AN INITIAL \$5,000 TO BEGIN INSTALLATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS** the City of Powder Springs previously engaged Croft & Associates to plan, design and recommend specifications for decorative items for city hall; and

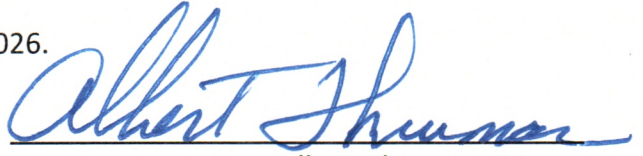
**WHEREAS** Croft & Associates has selected decorative items and the placement for each item, including the placement of previous photos of mayors serving the city, and the city desires to approve and authorize the recommendations provided by Croft & Associates; and

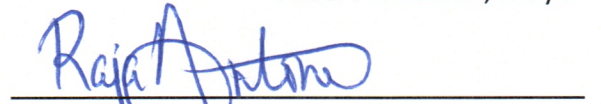
**WHEREAS** the purchase price is known and the city desires to authorize Croft & Associates to proceed with the purchase of decorative items and to obtain labor costs for installation; and

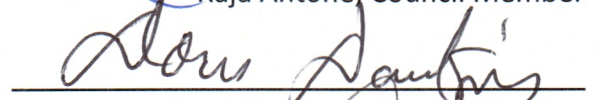
**WHEREAS** to enable installation to begin prior to the next regular council meeting on August 20, 2026, the city desires to authorize installation costs of up to \$5,000 to begin the installation process until Croft & Associates can obtain and present the complete installation schedule.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the mayor to execute agreements or documents that may be needed to purchase, deliver and begin installation of decorative moveable items such as art and plants and framed photographs for an amount of \$28,000 for said items and up to \$5,000 to begin installation.

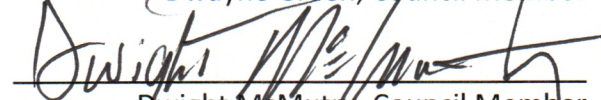

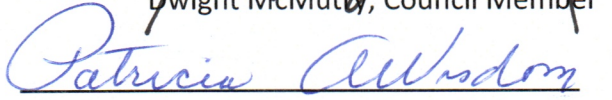

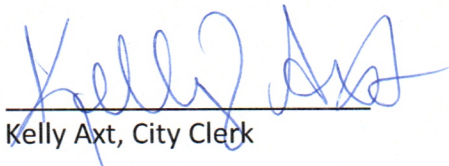
