A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH GAMETIME TO REPLACE PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT AT THE HOPKINS ROAD PEDESTRIAN PARK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$84,007.98; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
