

RESOLUTION 2026 - 076

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF SOLAR CONTROL WINDOW FILM ON CITY HALL TO IMPROVE ENERGY EFFICIENCY, CONTROL INTERIOR TEMPERATURES AND REDUCE GLARE FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$40,000; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS TO EFFECTUATE SAME; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs is committed to environmental sustainability, reducing energy consumption, and responsible stewardship of public funds; and

WHEREAS while energy efficiency was accounted City Hall has experienced greater than expected solar heat gain and high energy demands for air conditioning during summer months, leading to uncomfortable interior working conditions in certain areas of the building; and

WHEREAS glare on the exterior windows inhibits the ability of staff to utilize digital screens effectively; and

WHEREAS the professional installation of solar control window film can significantly reduce solar heat gain by up to 60% or more, reducing peak energy demand and creating a more consistent, comfortable climate; and

WHEREAS window film acts as a protective barrier, screening out up to 99% of dangerous UV rays, protecting building occupants, and reducing the fading of interior furnishings; and

WHEREAS it is determined to be in the best interest of the City to approve a contract for the purchase and installation of high-performance energy-saving window film on the south, east and west faces of the building.

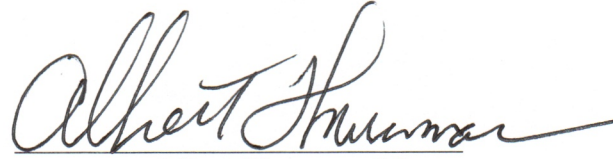
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that the purchase and installation of solar control window film for City Hall for an amount not to exceed \$40,000 is approved, and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement to effectuate same subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the film shall meet or exceed industry standards for non-reflective or low-reflective solar control and be installed by a professional service in accordance with manufacturer specifications, and funding shall be allocated from the Contingency line item within the General Fund in the Administration budget.

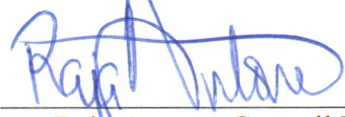
