A RESOLUTION AUTHORZING THE MAYOR AND CHIEF OF POLICE TO COMPLETE, EXECUTE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GEORGIA LAW ENFORCEMENT CERTIFICATION PROGRAM; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the Georgia Association of Chiefs of Police with the Georgia Police Accreditation Coalition previously developed a Georgia Law Enforcement Certification Program (GLECP) setting forth law enforcement agency standards;

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs desires to submit an application to participate in GLECP and commit to earning certification in accordance with the requirements set forth by the Georgia Association of Chief of Police;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor and Chief of Police are authorized to complete, execute and submit an application to participate in the Georgia Law Enforcement Certification Program, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
