

## RESOLUTION 2023 - 178


**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF NEW MACLAND ROAD, AND AFFECTED SIDE STREETS, FROM MACEDONIA ROAD TO THE CITY'S NORTHERN BOUNDARY LIMITS TO ACCOMMODATE THE MCEACHERN HIGH SCHOOL HOMECOMING PARADE ON OCTOBER 4, 2023; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY TRAFFIC CONTROL BY THE POLICE AND PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**


**WHEREAS**, McEachern High School celebrates its homecoming the week of October 2, 2023 and has submitted an application to hold a homecoming parade from 5:00 PM to 6:30 PM beginning at the intersection of Macedonia Road and New Macland Road and terminating at McEachern High School;

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that New Macland Road and Macedonia Roads shall be temporarily closed beginning at the intersection of New Macland Road and Macedonia Road, including affected side streets, and continuing into the unincorporated area of Cobb County just south of Glenn Road from 5:00 PM to 6:30 PM on October 4, 2023 in order to accommodate the McEachern High School homecoming parade.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Police and Public Works Departments are authorized to take necessary action to provide appropriate traffic control along the affected roadways.






