

RESOLUTION 2026 - 060

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH COBB COUNTY RELATING TO THE UPGRADE, FUNDING, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT CERTAIN LOCATIONS WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (CITY) and Cobb County, Georgia (COUNTY) previously entered into a Cobb Framework Agreement (the "Agreement") on October 10, 2022, for services associated with the construction of three traffic signals along Marietta St. at three intersections within the city limits, including Brownsville Road, New Macland Road and Austell-Powder Springs Road, collectively referred to as the "PROJECT"; and

WHEREAS, the parties amended the Agreement on December 19, 2023 by removing one of the signal locations from the Agreement, revising the maximum financial contribution of the CITY for the PROJECT from \$900,000.00 to \$1,073,904.42, and revising the time period for the COUNTY's withholding of \$35,000 from the CITY's 2022 SPLOST allocation for an additional 5 months, for a total of 31 months, for a total amount withheld of \$1,085,000.00 to cover the total revised anticipated maximum financial contribution.


WHEREAS, the PROJECT has been completed, and the final actual PROJECT costs are \$966,616.04, and the City and County desire to further amend the project to reflect actual costs, and return withheld funds, and close the project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that the mayor is authorized to execute an amendment to the agreement with Cobb County to reflect the final PROJECT costs at \$966,616.04, return withheld dollars and close the project.


