

## RESOLUTION NO. 2016-061

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**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROVING THE PROPOSAL SUBMITTED BY ARDITO CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC. FOR THE INSTALLATION OF NEW WATER LINE, CONNECTION OF WATER SERVICE AND DISCONNECTCION OF EXISTING SERVICE LINE ON MACEDONIA ROAD AND AT TAPP MIDDLE SCHOOL; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH ARDITO CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC. FOR SAID SERVICES FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$101,622.03; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

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**WHEREAS**, Cobb County-Marietta Water Authority (CCMWA) field crews recently conducted flow testing on CCMWA's 36-inch transmission main near Tapp Middle School and found the meter serving Tapp Middle School is served directly from CCMWA's 36-inch transmission main and serves only the school;

**WHEREAS**, Tapp Middle School should be served from a distribution line rather than a transmission main;

**WHEREAS**, the field crews found that a 6-inch City of Powder Springs ("City") distribution line running parallel with CCMWA's 36-inch transmission main is fed from a non-metered connection to CCMWA's transmission system, and the tap needs to be moved to the other side of CCMWA's meter at the location.

**WHEREAS**, the City has been working with CCMWA to develop a solution to disconnect an existing 6" unmetered water line at the northeast corner of Old Villa Rica Road, abandon said line in place in accordance with state regulations, extend and connect an existing 12" metered water line from said corner to the existing 6" line running south via a Tee connection, continue the 12" water line along the north side of Macedonia Road approximately 650 linear feet to the east towards Forest Hill Road, disconnect and plug an existing service to Tapp Middle School from a 36" water line owned by CCWMA, add a new 8" meter and reconnect to the existing service line for the school;

**WHEREAS**, time is of the essence requiring all work to be completed while school is out of session so that water is available and restored to the school before August 2016 in advance of opening day of the 2016-17 school session;

**WHEREAS**, the City requested and obtained a bid for said service and desires to accept and approve the bid submitted by Ardito Construction, Inc. for \$101,622.03; and

**WHEREAS**, funding shall be provided from the water fund budget.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and approves the bid submitted by Ardito Construction Company, Inc. for water line installation, connection and disconnection, and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement to effectuate same after review and approval by the City Attorney. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.




