

RESOLUTION 2020 -008

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A PERFORMANCE CONTRACT WITH THE COBB COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT TO HOLD THE TAPP MIDDLE SCHOOL EIGHT GRADE DANCE AT THE FORD CENTER RECEPTION HALL ON MAY 1, 2020; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Tapp Middle School, which is part of the Cobb County School District, will hold an Eighth Grade Dance on May 1, 2020 and wishes to secure the Ford Center Reception Hall as a venue for the event; and

WHEREAS, the City is willing to allow the school's rental of the facility for the sum of \$150 under the terms of the free use policy, but in order to secure funding to compensate the City for such rental, the Cobb County School District requires that the City execute the District's standard form Performance Contract; and

WHEREAS, the City is willing to execute such Performance Contract.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the Performance Contract of the Cobb County School District for the rental of the Ford Center Reception Hall for the Tapp Middle School Eighth District is hereby approved, and the Mayor is authorized to execute said Performance Contract, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
