A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CERTAIN MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF RETIRED PEOPLE SPECIFYING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS RELATED TO THE ACCEPTANCE AND USE OF GRANT FUNDS PROVIDED BY AARP COMMUNITY CHALLENGE GRANT PROGRAM PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
