A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 3-YEAR GEORGIA PLACEMAKING COLLABORATIVE PROGRAM FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$5,500; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Georgia Cities Foundation has opened its application process for the Georgia Placemaking Collaborative ("GPC") program;

WHEREAS, the GPC is a three-year facilitated program designed to assist participating communities in identifying their unique assets to develop strategies and outcomes centered around quality of life and economic sustainability, with the first year focused on Placemaking Education, Community Vision and Planning, the second year focused on Placemaking Project Development, Funding, and Implementation and the third year focused on Placemaking Tracking and Impact analysis;

WHEREAS, the annual cost for each of the three years is estimated to be \$5500.00, and the deadline for application submittal is December 20, 2019;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor is authorized to execute an application to participate in the 3-year Georgia Placemaking Collaborative program, which includes an estimated annual cost of \$5500.00. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval.
