A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH RCS PRODUCTIONS FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED FOR AND AT A SUMMER CONCERT SERIES IN THE NEW DOWNTOWN PARK FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$40,000; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") desires to conduct a summer concert series in its new downtown park to provide musical entertainment for residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, RCS Productions has been providing single as well as series entertainment throughout the Atlanta area since 1982, including with the City of Powder Springs, Woodstock and Fayetteville to name a few; and

WHEREAS, RCS has submitted a proposal to bring 4 concerts to the City's new downtown park on July 18, August 15 and September 12, 2020 and May 16, 2021 as described in the attached proposal, and the City desires to accept said proposal and engage RCS Productions in order to book and secure the bands for the 2020 concert series; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the proposal submitted by RCS Productions to bring a summer concert series to the new downtown park at a cost of \$40,000.00 is approved, and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement with RCS Productions, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
