

RESOLUTION NO. 2023 - 180

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH TERRACON TO TAKE ALL STEPS NEEDED TO ANALYZE, REMOVE, REPORT AND CLOSE UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS LOCATED AT THE MUNICIPAL COURT PROPERTY ON PINEVIEW DRIVE FOR AN AMOUNT UP TO \$59,620.00; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS during excavation under a land disturbance permit issued for the construction of a parking deck to be located behind the municipal court building, the contractor discovered underground storage tanks; and


WHEREAS in the interest of public health, safety and welfare and upon the advice of the contractor and program manager, the City Manager determined it necessary to immediately investigate and remedy any hazardous condition that existed on said property, and the Mayor executed an agreement to engage Terracon to take such steps needed to determine if any hazardous materials existed and if so to immediately close and remove the materials; and


WHEREAS the City desires to ratify the emergency action taken to address the unearthed tanks.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Terracon for an amount up to \$59,620 to assess and remedy the existence of hazardous materials that may exist on site and in the underground storage tanks discovered on property located behind the municipal court building and ratifies execution of said agreement. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
