A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CITY'S 401(A) PROFIT SHARING RETIREMENT PLAN; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTATION NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE SAME; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs did previously establish a profit sharing retirement plan (401a) and a deferred compensation plan (457) to be administered by the ICMA Retirement Corporation as a benefit to its employees; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to amend the 401(a) Plan to allow in-service distributions to plan participants who have attained the age of fifty-nine and one-half (59 ½) years.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that the City's 401(a) Plan be amended to allow in-service distributions to plan participants who have attained the age of fifty-nine and one-half (59 $\frac{1}{2}$) years; the Mayor is authorized to execute any documentation necessary to effectuate same. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
