A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A DEDUCTIVE CHANGE ORDER TO THE AGREEMENT WITH EAST COAST GRADING RELATING TO THE RESURFACING PROJECT UNDER THE LOCAL MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT GRANT (LMIG) PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
