A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONSERVATION EASEMENT GRANTED THE CITY OF POWDER SPRINGS FOR THE PROTECTION OF CERTAIN STREAM BUFFERS LOCATED WITHIN CERTAIN DEVELOPMENTS WITHIN INNOVATIVE WAY/INTERMODAL 20 WEST, NATURE WALK, WESTMONT PRESERVE, LEWIS-WILDWOOD AND CONCORD OAKS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS various developments within the City of Powder Springs contain a creek or stream considered to be state waters that are required to be protected by a buffer; and

WHEREAS the owners of said developments desire to grant and the City of Powder Springs desires to accept conservation easements to protect the affected stream buffer areas.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that conservation easements granted over an area of stream buffer within the developments of Innovate Way/20 Intermodal West, Nature Walk, Westmont Preserve, Lewis-Wildwood and Concord Oaks, are hereby accepted, and the Mayor is authorized to execute acceptance of same, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
