

RESOLUTION 2024 - 025

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH GEORGIA POWER COMPANY TO RELOCATE A METER AND UTILITIES IN THE DOWNTOWN; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs is vested with the legal authority to provide lighting to public property and previously authorized the relocation of underground service for a service pedestal and convert existing overhead by Resolution 2023-097; and

WHEREAS the City subsequently relocated the emergency siren from Pineview Drive to Lewis Road, requiring electrical service from the pole adjacent to the municipal parking lot and previously authorized for relocation; and


WHEREAS the relocation can occur with the continued provision of service to the emergency siren in a separate easement authorization, and Georgia Power is willing and able to provide said services for a revised fee of \$22,659.12.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the mayor to execute an agreement with Georgia Power Company to relocate a meter for underground service for a service pedestal, convert existing overhead and provide continuous service to the emergency siren, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.






