A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR AND COMMITMENT TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS THROUGH THE ATLANTA REGIONAL COMMISSION TO INCLUDE CERTAIN TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS IN THE STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM IN ORDER TO SEEK AND RECEIVE FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION; ACKNOWLEDGING THE NEED FOR LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the Atlanta Regional Commission ("ARC") has issued a call for projects inviting local jurisdictions to apply for funding assistance through ARC's Georgia Transportation Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS the City desires to apply for inclusion in the TIP and funding assistance to implement transportation improvements at Oglesby and Lewis Roads and at CH James Parkway and Sweetwater Avenue to improve and better manage travel conditions on said roads for the benefit of the residents and businesses of the City, visitors and commerce; and

WHEREAS an application requires a letter or resolution of commitment to the project and an acknowledgement of the need for matching funds, as applicable; and

WHEREAS the local match amount, which is 20% of total project costs, will be determined based on factors that include, but are not limited to, the final scope of the project as agreed upon by the City and ARC and resources committed to the project by both parties; and

WHEREAS the City finds that transportation improvements on Oglesby and Lewis Roads and at CH James Parkway and Sweetwater Avenue would result in safer, improved and better managed travel conditions, and it desires to provide a resolution of support for and commitment to the projects and acknowledge that matching funds are required.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it supports and is committed to transportation improvements for inclusion in the state transportation improvement program and funding assistance, which includes a local match of 20% of project costs.
