A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH S.H. CREEL CONTRACTING FOR A SUM OF \$8,750 TO DEMOLISH AND REMOVE A DILAPIDATED FENCE AROUND A CITY-OWNED DETENTION POND AND INSTALL A REPLACEMENT SIX-FOOT BLACK CHAIN LINK FENCE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") Public Works Department has identified a dilapidated and deficient fence around a city-owned detention pond on Elliott Road and recommends its replacement; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited and obtained quotes and desires to accept the quote submitted by S.H. Creek Contracting to demolish and remove a dilapidated and deficient privacy fence located around a detention pond on Elliott Road and replace it with a six-foot black chain link fence;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the purchase and installation of a replacement fence round a city-owned detention pond and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with S.H. Creel Contracting for said fence and work; subject to review and approval of the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
