

## RESOLUTION 2025 - 124

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DIRECTOR OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH THE GEORGIA CRIME INFORMATION CENTER (GCIC) TO ACCESS BACKGROUND INFORMATION RELATING TO APPLICANTS FOR ALCOHOL LICENSES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


**WHEREAS** the City of Powder Springs ("City") alcohol beverage ordinance requires background checks of applicants for alcohol licenses; and


**WHEREAS** the licensing authority is required to have its own Originating Agency Identifier ("ORI") number to conduct a federal background check, and the City previously approved an agreement to enable the Community Development Department to obtain its ORI to conduct the required background check of alcohol license applicants; and


**WHEREAS** the current agreement authorizing the Community Development Department to access said information is subject to renewal, and includes the former department director, and the City desires to authorize the Community Development Director or his or her designee and Mayor to execute an agreement with GCIC to access information needed to conduct a background check.


