A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR CERTAIN PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RELATED TO SERVICE DELIVERY FOR AN AMOUNT UP TO \$9,000; AMENDING AN AGREEMENT FOR CERTAIN PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RELATED TO SERVICE DELIVERY FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$3,000; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES..

WHEREAS the currently effective service delivery plan governing the City of Powder Springs will expire in 2024 and a new plan must be submitted to the Department of Community Affairs prior to adoption; and

WHEREAS the City has begun its assessment of services and funding in order to update and certify said plan during upcoming negotiations with the county and other cities, and previously approved an agreement for professional services of an experienced consultant with substantial experience and expertise in service delivery; and

WHEREAS the City requested additional review of services, revenues and expenditures that require more hours than initially anticipated; and

WHEREAS recent discussions with Cobb County and the other cities also indicate a need for professional services for intergovernmental consulting to facilitate discussions and dialogue between the county and the cities; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an amendment to the agreement with Brown Pelican Consulting for an amount up to \$3,000, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Balli Law LLC for an amount of up to \$9,000, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall be effective November 6, 2023.
