A RESOLUTION PROVIDING THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES CERTAIN ASSURANCES RELATED TO AN APPLICATION FOR LAND WATER CONSERVATION FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR THE CITY OF POWDER SPRINGS PARK PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs (the "City") desires to submit a pre-application for funding from the federal Land and Water Conservation Fund ("LWCF") to offset costs of constructing improvements in Powder Springs Park as recommended in the City's Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax ("SPLOST") program; and

WHEREAS if the City's pre-application for funding from the LWCF is recommended for funding by the Georgia Department of Natural Resources ("DNR"), the DNR requires assurance by the City that the City has the ability and intention to finance its local match of 50+ percent of the total project cost and will submit to DNR appropriate documentation required for a formal LWCF application.

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it certifies and assures the Georgia Department of Natural Resources that it has the ability and intention to finance its local match of 50+ percent of the total project cost and will submit appropriate documentation required by DNR for the formal LWCF application for funding assistance for its Powder Springs Park project as recommended in the City's SPLOST program. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
