A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE A RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH THE GEORGIA CRIME INFORMATION CENTER (GCIC) TO ACCESS BACKGROUND INFORMATION RELATING TO APPLICANTS FOR ALCOHOL LICENSES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") alcohol beverage ordinance requires background checks of applicants for alcohol licenses; and

WHEREAS, the licensing authority is required to have its own Originating Agency Identifier ("ORI") number in order to conduct a federal background check, and the City previously approved an agreement to enable the Community Development Department to obtain its ORI in order to conduct the required background check of alcohol license applicants; and

WHEREAS, the current agreement authorizing the Community Development Department to access said information is subject to renewal and the City desires to authorize the Community Development Director and Mayor to execute a renewal agreement with GCIC to access information needed to conduct a federal background check.

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor and Community Development Director are authorized to execute an agreement with the Georgia Crime Information Center for the purposes of conducting the required background check of alcohol license applicants.
