RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - 011

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING BY ONE YEAR THE AGREEMENT WITH HARDY FAMILY AUTOMOTIVE GROUP FOR THE NAMING RIGHTS FOR THE AMPHITHEATER IN THURMAN SPRINGS PARK; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") previously solicited proposals to associate a corporate name with the new amphitheater in the downtown park originally scheduled to open spring 2020;

WHEREAS, the City approved the proposal from Hardy Family Automotive Group for the naming rights of the new amphitheater for three years through October 2022;

WHEREAS, the completion of Thurman Springs Park was delayed as a result of the impacts of the global pandemic caused by the novel coronavirus ("COVID 19") delaying a number of park events, including the grand opening, summer concert series and the Independence Day celebration;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council extended the various contracts for the use of Thurman Springs Park by a year and finds it in the public interest to similarly also extend the naming rights agreement with Hardy Family Automotive Group for an additional year to October 2023;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the agreement with the Hardy Family Automotive Group for the naming rights of the new amphitheater in Thurman Springs Park is extended by an additional year, and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement extension with Hardy Family Automotive Group, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
