WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") has received a temporary special event application from Prayer by Painting to host a prayer and worship service at Thurman Springs Park on May 31, 2025 from noon to 6:00PM and

WHEREAS the City desires to accommodate the temporary event and allow the temporary closure and use of certain public spaces to further its strategic priorities of creating an atmosphere of community and creating destinations that appeal to residents and visitors.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the temporary closure and use of Thurman Springs Park, on May 31, 2025 from noon to 6:00pm, subject to the applicant providing security and traffic control as determined by the Chief of Police, providing for sanitation and clean up following the event as determined by the Public Work Sanitation Director and providing written notice of the event at least 30 days in advance of the event to the businesses located in the downtown, with said notice also provided to the Parks Department.
