A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS FOR VARIOUS CITY FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS USING SPECIAL PURPOSE LOCAL OPTION SALES TAX DOLLARS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs has conducted inspections and found several City Facilities to be in need of various improvements; and

WHEREAS, competitive bids were taken for City Hall elevator improvements, and Premier Elevator Co., Inc. was found to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder with a bid of \$2,535.00, and the City desires to accept and approve said bid; and

WHEREAS, competitive bids were taken for Municipal Court Electrical improvements, and Knine All Systems Inc. was found to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder with a bid of \$4,998.00, and the City desires to accept and approve said bid; and

WHEREAS, competitive bids were taken for Police Department Erosion improvements, and Tucker Grading was found to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder with a bid of \$4,825.00, and the City desires to accept and approve said bid; and

WHEREAS, competitive bids were taken for the Senior Center Awning Replacement, and R.A.K Roofing and Construction was found to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder with a bid of \$2,800.00, and the City desires to accept and approve said bid; and

WHEREAS, competitive bids were taken for the Bodiford House Roof Replacement, and R.A.K Roofing and Construction was found to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder with a bid of \$15,131.00, and the City desires to accept and approve said bid; and

WHEREAS, competitive bids were taken for the replacement of water heaters in various City facilities, and Atlanta Air Care was found to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder with a total bid of \$10,500.00 for six (6) water heater replacements, and the City desires to accept and approve said bid; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing facility improvements will be paid for with 2016 Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax dollars approved for city facilities; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and approves the bids as set forth herein for facility improvements authorized under the 2016 SPLOST program, and it authorizes the Mayor to execute the necessary agreements to effectuate same, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
