Meeting

City Manager Pam Conner led an overview, with John Leggett of MSI, and city staff of the proposed health care and ancillary benefits for 2024 open enrollment. Ms. Conner presented changes to the Kaiser enrollment levels designed to address concerns raised through an employee survey and feedback from employee informational sessions with MSI - the City's benefit broker. The two chief concerns were deductible levels and proximity to Kaiser locations.

MOT 24 -005 Motion - Recommendation for 24-25 Healthcare Provider

A motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem - Ward 1 Lust, seconded by Council Member - Ward 3 Green, that this Motion 24-005 was approved as read by City Manager Pam Conner:

Motion to approve the recommendation to remain with Kaiser this plan year with the following modifications:

- 1. The city will cover the premiums for all employees on the HSA (high deductible plan).
- 2. The HSA contributions by the City to the employee's accounts will increase from \$1300 to \$1500 and from \$2600 to \$3000.
- 3. The HRA contributions will increase from \$300 to \$500 and from \$600 to \$1000.
- 4. For those employees whose residence is greater than 30 miles from the Kennesaw location, the HMO and PPO plans will receive a \$30 subsidy, thereby lowering the premium by \$30.
- 5. The dental, vision, life and disability will move to Standard with the dental plan providing higher benefits.
- 6. A spousal surcharge will apply.
