

Resolution No. 2022 - 181

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH TYLER TECHNOLOGIES, INC. FOR A COMPREHENSIVE CLOUD BASED ACCOUNTING SYSTEM FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$137,850 AND FOR IMPLEMENTATION TRAINING FOR AN AMOUNT UP TO \$12,150 FOR A TOTAL OF \$150,000; AUTHORIZING ANNUAL OPERATING SOFTWARE FEE OF \$55,136; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") has an established need for and did solicit proposals for a comprehensive cloud-based accounting system consistent and in compliance with a certain Request for Proposal issued August 2022; and


WHEREAS following review and analysis by the Finance Department and city management of the submitted proposals, the City desires to accept the proposal submitted by Tyler Technologies, Inc. ("Tyler") for the set up amount of \$137,850 and three one-year software renewals of \$55,136 each; and

WHEREAS the City further desires to authorize additional implementation training by Tyler, if needed, for the amount of \$12,150 and annual software renewal fees of \$55,136 each for three one-year terms;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Tyler Technologies for a comprehensive cloud based accounting system consistent with the RFP issued in August 2022 for an amount of \$137,850.00, for additional implementation training if needed for an amount up to \$12,150.00 and for three one-year terms to renew software for an amount of \$55,136 each, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.




