

## RESOLUTION NO. 2025 - 086

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT OR DOCUMENTS NEEDED TO AUTHORIZE VC3 TO CONFIGURE RECENTLY PURCHASED LAPTOPS WITH ALL SYSTEM FEATURES NEEDED FOR SYSTEM SUPPORT FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$24,780; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**


**WHEREAS** the City of Powder Springs (hereinafter "the City") previously authorized through Resolutions 2025-057 and 061 the purchase of laptops because of warranty expiration and Windows 11 upgrades; and


**WHEREAS** the purchase did not include the necessary work to configure the laptops with all appropriate system features supported by the City's Information Technology provider, VC3, and the city desires to authorize the necessary configuration; and

**WHEREAS** the configuration will be completed before end of the fiscal year and will be paid with savings from the current budget year resulting from vacancies in the administration budget that will be reflected in a budget amendment to be prepared by the Finance department.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with VC3 to configure laptops for a sum of \$24,780, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney, and for the Finance Director to prepare the corresponding budget amendment.




